

WATERFRONT CULTURAL CORE AROUND MACHINE SHOP

CULTURAL CORRIDOR FROM HIGH SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY CENTRE WITH PEDESTRIAN OVERPASS TO WATERFRONT LANDS

DEVELOP GREENWAY ALONG ROCKY CREEK CORRIDOR WITHIN TOWN PROPERTY AND IN PARTNERSHIP WITH OTHER STAKEHOLDER'S LAND

INCLUDE WATERFRONT WALKWAY/TRAILS INTO WATERFRONT AREA PLAN

DEVELOP ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION CORRIDOR (MULTI-USE PATHWAY) ALONG DOGWOOD DRIVE

IMPROVE TRANS CANADA TRAIL WITH BETTER CONNECTIONS TO AND FROM ITS LENGTH

DEVELOP A SITE PLAN FOR GOLF COURSE AND HOLLAND CREEK BALL FACILITIES TO INCREASE AND PROVIDE FURTHER PROGRAMMABLE USES. WITH THE OBJECTIVE TO HAVE GREATER UTILIZATION OF THE SITE. THE FACILITIES WOULD BECOME MULTI-USE - SOCCER IN WINTER, BALL IN SPRING, AND WOULD INCLUDE A FENCED DOG AREA, DISC GOLF AND THE ADDITION OF LIGHTING FOR EVENING USAGE

REDEVELOP SITE PLAN FOR LOT 108 WITH A REVIEW OF AMENITIES REQUIRED INCLUDING:

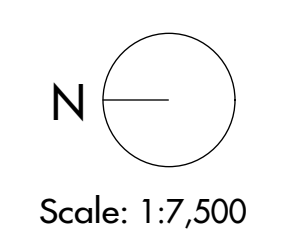
