



Water Restrictions Eased

Effective September 20, 2017

Stage 1 WATER REGULATIONS

Lawn Sprinkling Times	7:00am - 9:00am OR 7:00pm - 9:00pm
Even Numbered Addresses - Even dates	
Odd Numbered Addresses - Odd dates	
Watering New Lawn	Same as above unless Sprinkling Permit is obtained
Hand Watering of Trees, Shrubs and Gardens <small>*Use hose with spring-loaded nozzle, watering pail or bucket</small>	Hand water between 7-9am or 7-9pm Maximum 2 hours per day
Micro or Drip Irrigation <small>*Exceptions: using less than 20 gallons per hour at less than 25psi. This does not include soaker or weeper hoses</small>	Any time - maximum 4hours per day
Filling Pools and Hot Tubs <small>*Exceptions: pools filled prior to Stage 3 may be topped up to account for evaporation losses in order to avoid damage to pumps, etc*</small>	Anytime
Washing Vehicles, Houses, Boats, RV's or Trailers	
Washing Driveways & Sidewalks <small>*Exceptions: Only permitted for preparation of applying paints, preservatives or for pouring concrete</small>	

Effective September 20th, 2017

Temporary Stage 3 Watering Restrictions have been lifted for the Town of Ladysmith, Diamond Improvement District and Stz'uminus First Nation. This temporary move allowed Town Public Works crews to perform routine maintenance on the Holland Lake Chicken Ladder intake. Thank you to all residents for doing your part during this time.

Why are we on Stage 1?

Before the temporary Stage 3 Water Restrictions came into effect, we were in Stage 2 restrictions. Due to recent rains, and cooler weather, restrictions have been eased to Stage 1. This restriction will be lifted October 31, 2017.
