ACCESSIBILITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE VACANCIES

Ladysmith Council is inviting applications from residents who would like to make Ladysmith a more accessible community.

The Town's newly formed Accessibility Advisory Committee (AAC) has six vacancies, each for a two-year term, ending September 30, 2025. The goal of this Committee is to assist the town in identifying barriers to individuals, and to advise the Town on how to remove and prevent such barriers.

Members at large will be appointed by Council based on their experience and involvement related to accessibility issues. To the extent possible, the membership should reflect the following:

- a. At least half of the Committee members appointed should be persons with disabilities or persons representing a disability-serving organization.
- b. At least one member appointed should be Indigenous.
