Stage 2 WATER REGULATIONS

Lawn Sprinkling Times	7:00am - 9:00am OR 7:00pm - 9:00pm
Even Numbered Addresses Wednesday & Saturday	
Odd Numbered Addresses Thursday & Sunday	
Watering New Lawn	NO PERMITS ISSUED
Hand Watering of Trees, Shrubs and Gardens <small>*Use hose with spring-loaded nozzle, watering pail or bucket</small>	Hand water between 7-9am or 7-9pm Maximum 2 hours per day
Micro or Drip Irrigation <small>*Exceptions: using less than 20 gallons per hour at less than 25psi. This does not include soaker or weeper hoses</small>	Any time - maximum 4 hours per day
Filling Pools and Hot Tubs <small>*Exceptions: pools filled prior to Stage 3 may be topped up to account for evaporation losses in order to avoid damage to pumps, etc</small>	Any time
Washing Vehicles, Houses, Boats, RV's or Trailers	
Washing Driveways & Sidewalks <small>*Exceptions: Only permitted for preparation of applying paints, preservatives or for pouring concrete</small>	NOT PERMITTED

Stage 2 Watering Restrictions for the entire Cowichan Valley Regional District, including the Town of Ladysmith, Diamond Improvement District, and Stz'uminus First Nation are in effect from June 14th until further notice.

Water restrictions are intended to help control water usage as demand increases with the hot, dry weather.

Remember, being water-wise throughout the year can also save you money. With a little effort, we can reduce the amount of water we use at home by as much as 40 percent!
