Effective May 1, 2020

Stage 2 WATER REGULATIONS

Lawn Sprinkling Times	<p>Permitted between 7 a.m. - 9 a.m. or 7 p.m. - 9 p.m.</p>
Even Numbered Addresses Wednesday and Saturday	
Odd Numbered Addresses Thursday and Sunday	
Watering New Lawn	<p>Not Permitted (No Permits Issued)</p>
Hand Watering of Trees, Shrubs and Gardens	<p>Permitted between 7 a.m. - 9 a.m. or 7 p.m. - 9 p.m. Maximum 2 hours per day</p>
<small>*Use hose with spring-loaded nozzle, watering pail or bucket</small>	
Micro or Drip Irrigation	<p>Permitted Anytime maximum 4 hours per day</p>
<small>*Exceptions: using less than 20 gallons per hour at less than 25psi. This does not include soaker or weeper hoses</small>	
Filling Pools and Hot Tubs	<p>Permitted Anytime</p>
<small>*Exceptions: pools filled prior to Stage 3 may be topped up to account for evaporation losses in order to avoid damage to pumps, etc*</small>	
Washing Vehicles, Houses, Boats, RV's or Trailers	
Washing Driveways & Sidewalks	<p>Not Permitted</p>
<small>*Exceptions: Only permitted for prepa- ration of applying paints/ preservatives or for pouring concrete</small>	

Stage 2 Water Restrictions for the Town of Ladysmith, Diamond Improvement District and Stz'uminus First Nation are in effect until further notice.

Restrictions are in place annually from May 1 to October 31.

The commissioning of the new Water Filtration Plant and resulting increased water use has in part meant that we are moving to Stage 2 earlier this year.

Water restrictions are intended to help control water usage as demand increases with the hot, dry weather.

Remember, being water-wise throughout the year can also save you money.
