BYLAW NO. 1457

Ticket Information Utilization

The Municipal Council of the Town of Ladysmith in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

- WHEREAS the Local Government Act empowers the Town of Ladysmith to, by bylaw, designate those bylaws for which municipal ticket information may be used as a means of bylaw enforcement;
- AND WHEREAS the Local Government Act empowers the Council to, by bylaw, designate a person who comes within a class of persons, as a Bylaw Enforcement Officer;
- AND WHEREAS the Local Government Act empowers the Council to, by bylaw, authorize the use of any word or expression on a municipal ticket information to designate an offense against a bylaw;
- AND WHEREAS the Local Government Act empowers the Council to, by bylaw, set fine amounts in consultation with the Chief Judge of the Provincial Court;
- AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient to authorize the use of municipal ticket information for the enforcement of certain bylaws, to authorize the use of certain words or expressions to designate certain bylaw offences and to set certain fine amounts.
- NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Ladysmith in open meeting assembled enacts as follows;
- 1. The Bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this bylaw, as amended from time to time, may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed for the purpose of Section 272 of the Local Government Act.
- 2. The persons appointed to the job positions or titles listed in Column 2 of Schedule 1 to this bylaw are designated as bylaw enforcement officers pursuant to Section 272(1)(b) of the Local Government Act for the purpose of enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule 1 opposite the respective job positions.
- 3. The words or expressions set forth in Column 1 of Schedule 2 through 11 to this bylaw designate the offence committed under the bylaw section number appearing in Column 2 opposite the respective words or expressions.
- 4. The amounts appearing in Column 3 of Schedules 2 through 11 to this bylaw are the fines set pursuant to Section 272(5) of the Local Government Act for the corresponding offences designated in Column 1.

- 5. This bylaw shall take effect upon the date of its adoption.
- 6. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Town of Ladysmith Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw 2002, No. 1457".
