PROCEDURE BYLAW AMENDMENTS



Amendments to “Council Procedure Bylaw 2009, No. 1666”

In accordance with Section 124 of the *Community Charter*, notice is given that the Council of the Town of Ladysmith intends to give final consideration to amendments to “Council Procedure Bylaw 2009, No. 1666” at its Regular meeting on September 16, 2025. In general terms, the amendment bylaw will:

- a. Expand meeting conduct expectations to include attendees;
- b. Grant all Council members who voted on the prevailing side the right to bring a previously voted-on matter back for reconsideration within 30 days;
- c. Provide additional grounds for denying delegation requests; and
- d. Update language pertaining to legal matters.
