Mail ballot packages will be available by early October (either by Canada Post standard mail service or pick up at the City Hall).

You are responsible for ensuring that your completed ballot and documents are received by the Chief Election Officer before the close of voting at 8:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 17, 2026 (General Voting Day). On General Voting Day City Hall will be closed so documents must be delivered to the Chief Election Officer at the Voting Place: Frank Jameson Community Centre at 810 6th Avenue.
