Pursuant to Section 494 of the *Local Government Act*, we advise you that Council is scheduled to consider the issuance of a Temporary Use Permit for 226 Buller Street.

Subject Property

226 Buller Street, Ladysmith (Lot 20, Block 45, Lot 56, Oyster District, Plan 703A)

What is the Proposal About?

The purpose of the proposed Temporary Use Permit is to permit Temporary Accommodation use at 226 Buller Street to authorize a Short-Term Rental within a Secondary Suite. The term of the proposed Permit would be three years with the option to apply for one renewal.
