



# Water Restrictions Stage 1

Effective May 1, 2025

## Stage 1 WATER RESTRICTIONS

**Outdoor watering is not permitted between  
9 a.m. and 7 p.m. for the days and times applicable below.**

Watering in the evening, nighttime or early morning reduces water wasted due to evaporation and spreads peak water use. If you're using an automated system, please schedule watering for the overnight hours.

### Sprinkling (lawns and gardens)

Even Addresses	<b>2 hours/day Wednesday &amp; Saturday only</b>
Odd Addresses	<b>2 hours/day Thursday &amp; Sunday only</b>
Watering New Lawn	<b>Sprinkling permit required*</b>

### Vegetable Gardens & Fruit Trees

Hand watering, Micro or Drip Irrigation	<b>4 hours/day</b>

### Ornamental Trees, Shrubs & Gardens

Hand watering	<b>2 hours/day</b>
Micro or Drip Irrigation	<b>2 hours/day</b>

### Other Outdoor Water Use

Filling Pools and Hot Tubs, Washing Vehicles or Boats, Washing Driveways, Houses & Sidewalks	<b>No Restrictions</b>

Stage 1 Water Restrictions come into effect May 1<sup>st</sup> for the Town of Ladysmith, Diamond Improvement District and Stz'uminus First Nation.

These annual restrictions are intended to help control water usage during the warmer, dryer weather.

Remember, being water-wise throughout the year can save you money. With a little effort, you can reduce the amount of water used at home by as much as 40 per cent!
