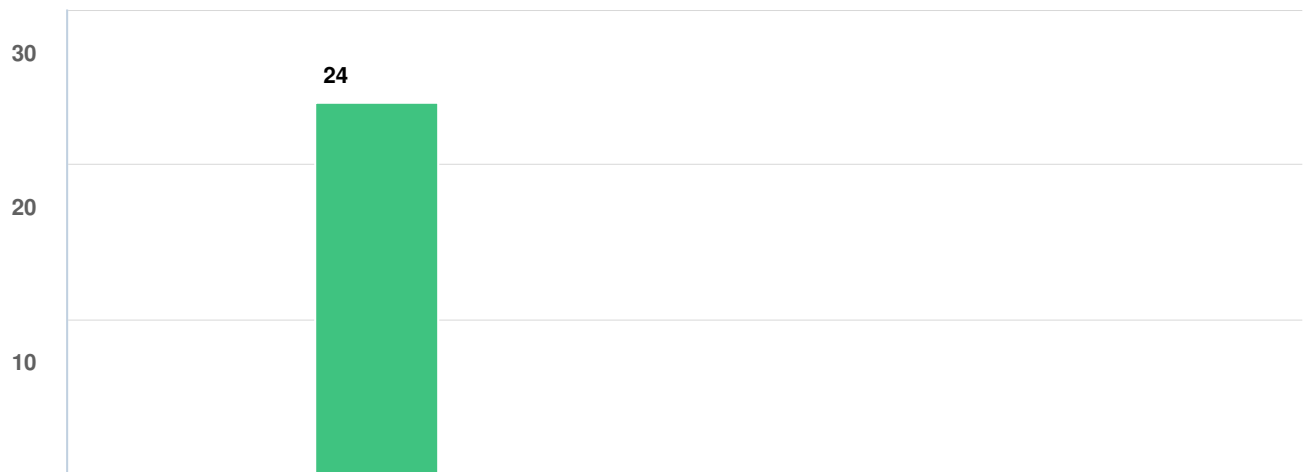

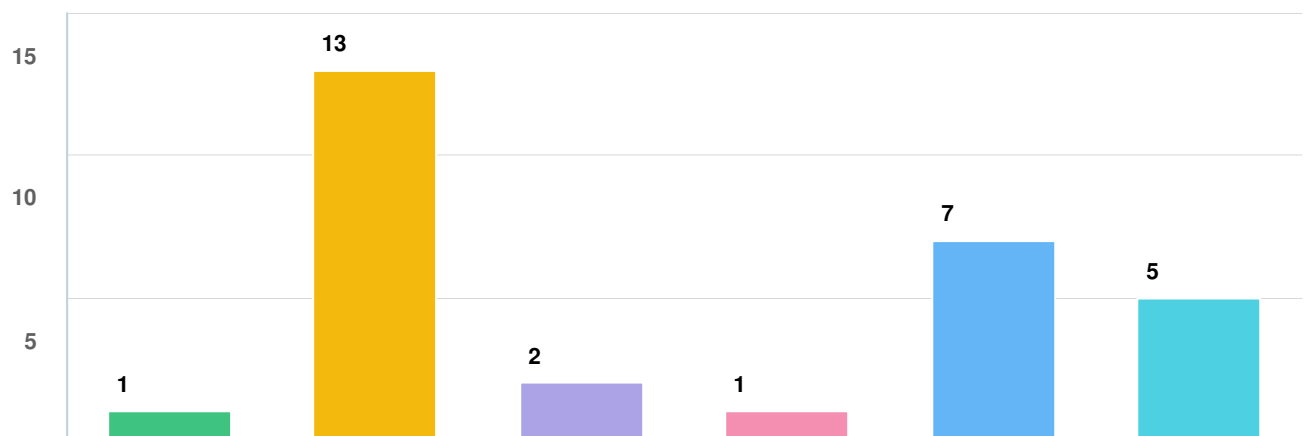

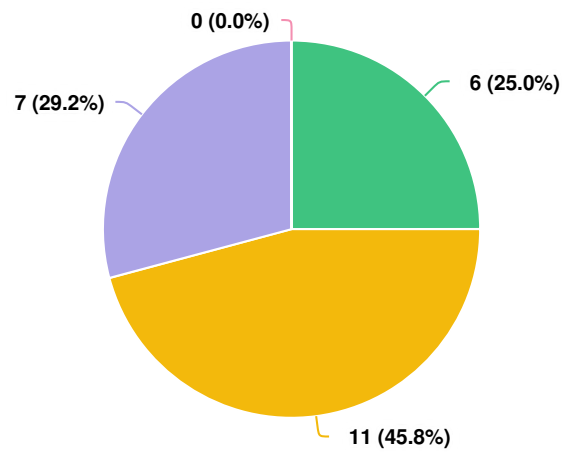

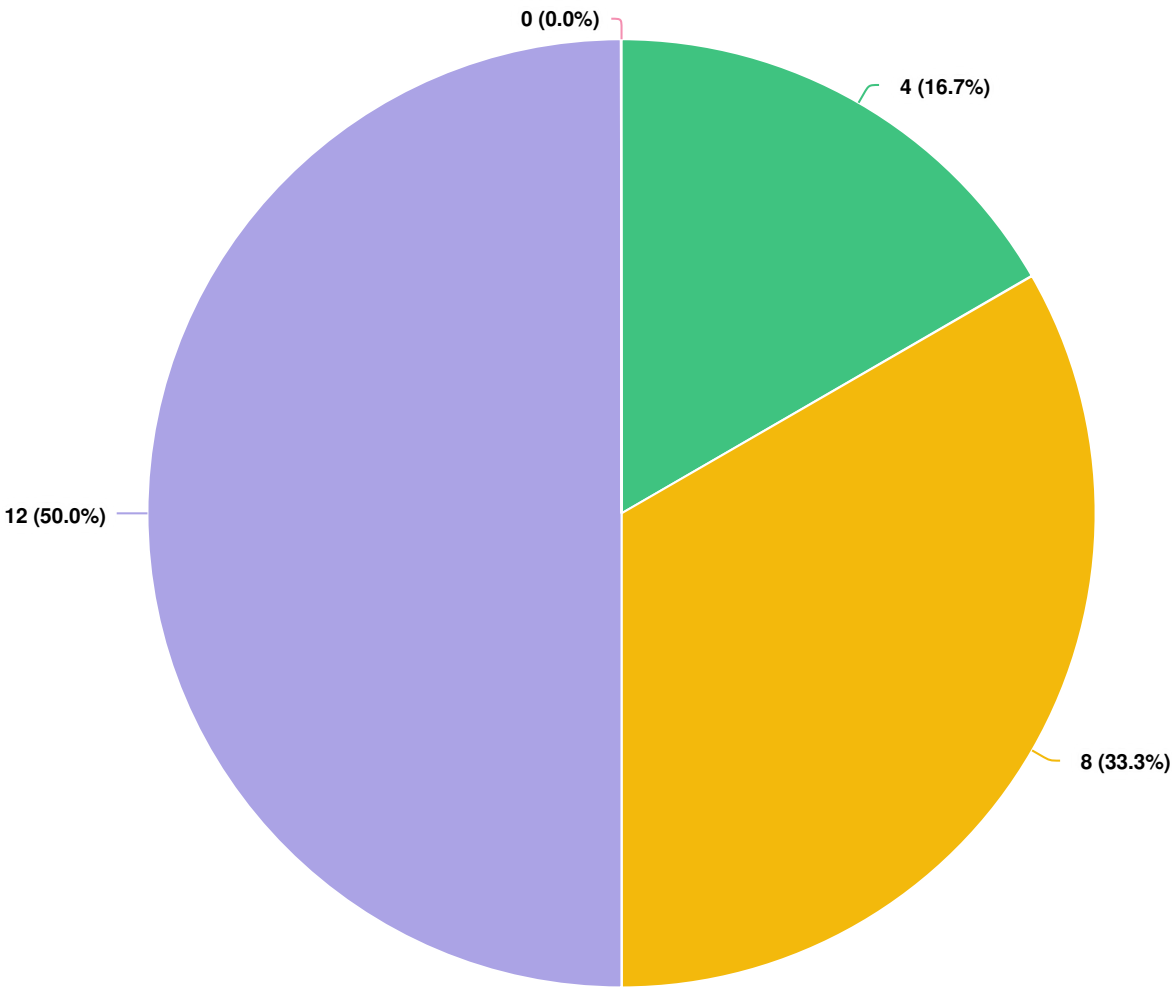

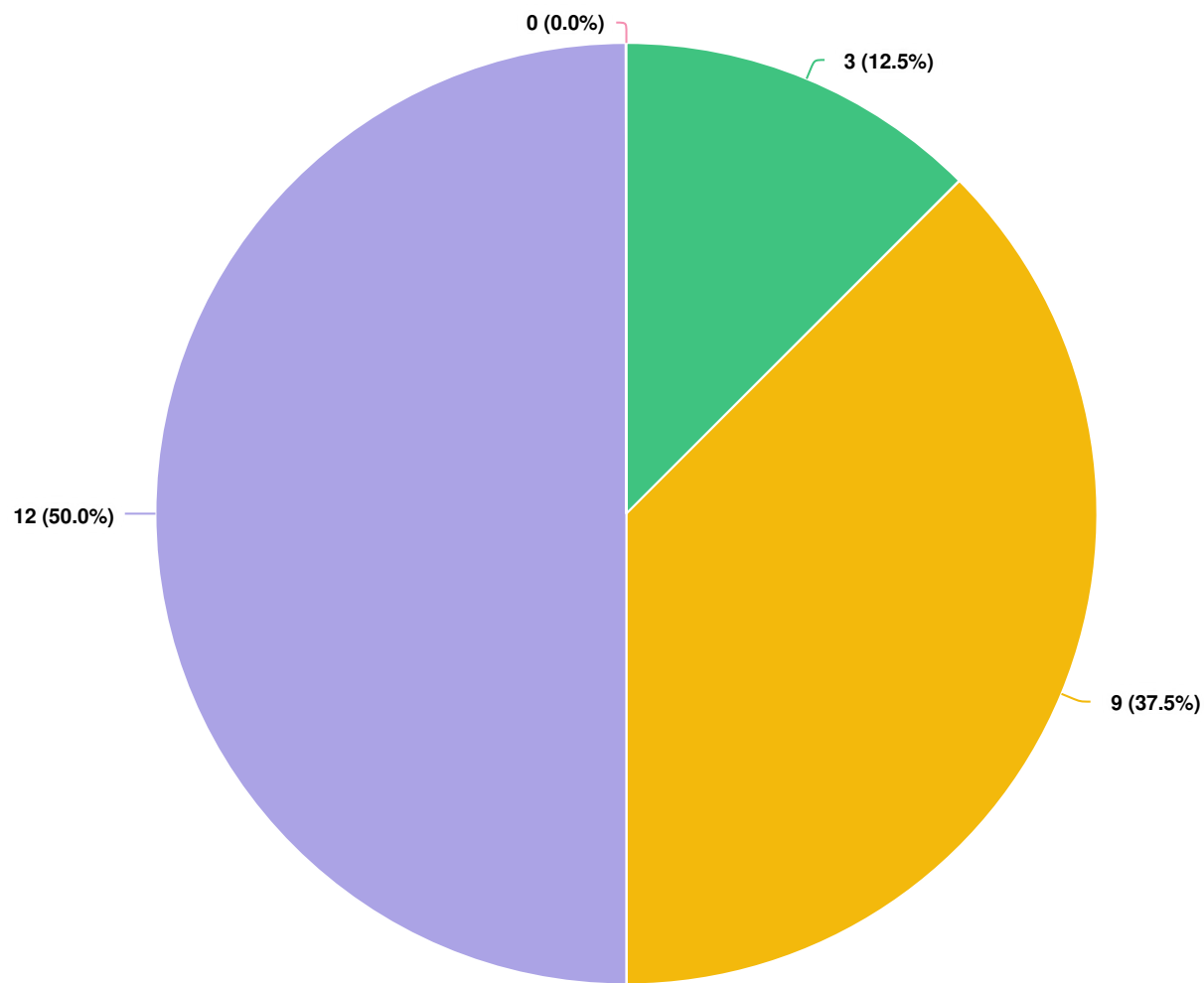

Q8 How would you rate the timeliness of the collection?

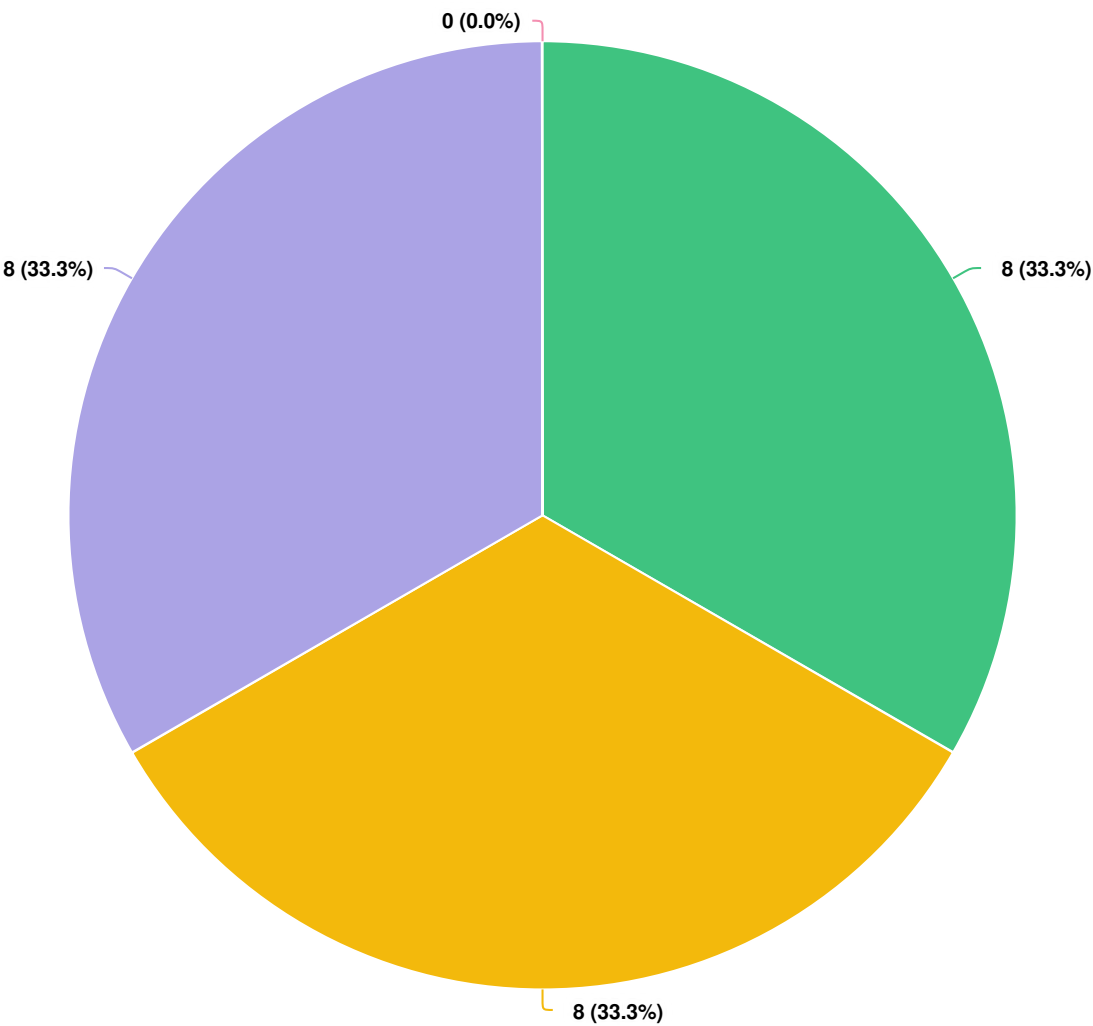

Q9 | How effective was the communication about Spring Clean-Up 2025?

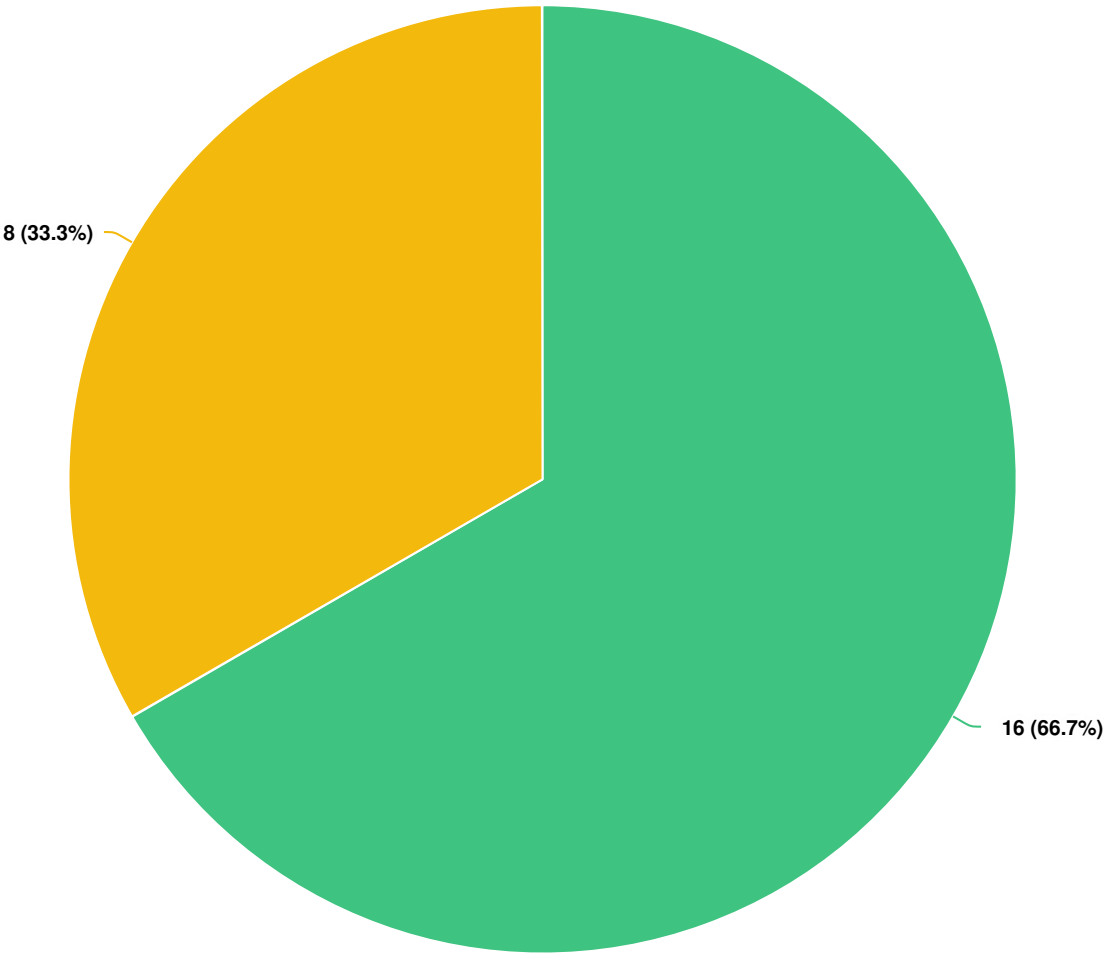

Q10 | Do you think Spring Clean-Up Week should continue in future years?

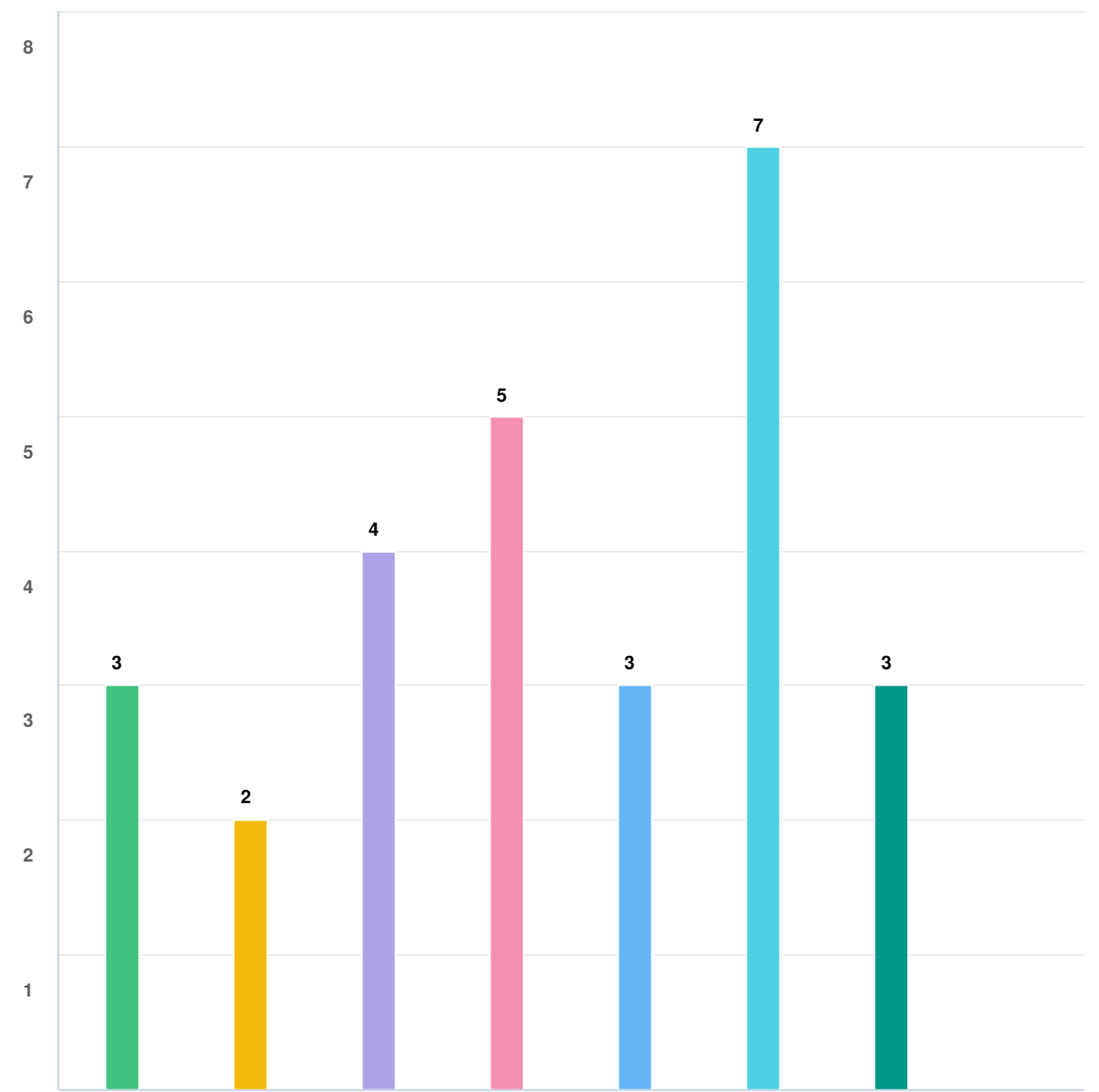
