Lyme Disease Awareness Month

- *WHEREAS*: Lyme disease has become the most frequently reported vectorborne disease in Canada and can impact the quality of life of individuals and their families in British Columbia and across Canada; and
- *WHEREAS*: Lyme disease and Lyme co-infections can be challenging to diagnose, and, if left untreated, symptoms may result in complicated multi-level infections that are life-altering; and
- *WHEREAS*: Lyme disease is preventable if the right precautions are taken, and it is important that everyone know how to protect themselves and their loved ones from this vector-borne disease; and
- *WHEREAS:* Lyme Disease Awareness Month is an opportunity to increase awareness of this potentially serious disease and to educate on prevention and recognition of early signs and symptoms.
