WHEREAS: Complex Regional Pain Syndrome (CRPS), also known as Reflex

Sympathetic Dystrophy (RSD) is a nerve disorder that causes chronic

pain.

**WHEREAS**: The symptoms of CRPS/RSD are often described as burning that is out of

proportion to the severity of the initial injury and can include swelling

and extreme sensitivity to touch.

**WHEREAS**: While CRPS/RSD was first identified during the Civil War, it remains a

poorly understood condition. There is no cure.

WHEREAS: The National Institute of Neurological Disorders and Stroke and other

institutes of the National Institutes of Health support research relating to

CRPS/RSD.

WHEREAS: Members of the CRPS/RSD community will spread awareness in
