UNFINISHED BUSINESS **Shower Only Fee at FJCC** - Commissioners discussed options for a shower only fee as well as alternative locations for residents and visitors showering in Ladysmith.

The Commission agreed that the following direct and point form wording for the sign is preferred; however it was considered that possibly the addition of “welcome” may be added:

2. I will treat all others and this facility with respect

3. I will interact in this facility in a safe and courteous manner

Failure to comply with this code of conduct may result in your immediate expulsion from this facility and/or limitations on your ability to enjoy its use.
